Requirements for Training Providers

In order to establish and maintain the required standard and integrity of the course modules, prospective training providers must comply with the minimum criteria specified in the application for registration.

These criteria are divided into two areas:

- Assessment of course presenters*
- Assessment of facilities*

Assessment Of Course Presenters

Those seeking to present the Ausjet General Safety Induction or Intermediate courses for Hydro-blasting, must present a resume of their qualifications and experience to Ausjet. As a minimum standard, presenters are required to hold qualifications in a relevant discipline and demonstrate significant industrial experience at a decision making level, or at a level where they were in a position to influence decision making.

In addition to the above, the prospective trainer is required to possess certificate 4 in workplace training and assessment. Prospective trainers must also demonstrate they have the specialist knowledge indicated in the content of the module they are involved in facilitating.

References from previous employers or evaluations from previous course attendees may also be required to be produced. In addition they may be required to present a "sample" session in order to demonstrate their understanding of the course content and their skills in delivering training courses to adults.

Assessment of Facilities

Prospective licensees must possess as a minimum, adequate facilities to present the theoretical portion of the courses in an environment conducive to effective presentation and learning.

These facilities should include:

- A classroom / seminar room*
- White board*
- Overhead projector*
- Examples of items described in the course content, i.e. personal safety equipment, tags,*

In addition to the above, the applicant must have adequate facilities to conduct the practical portion of the courses along with a high pressure water jetting pump, accessories and all safety equipment necessary.

If you consider your organization and trainers fulfill the above requirements, please complete the enclosed form and forward it to Ausjet along with all required supporting documentation.
