

Safety Alert!

During work with an LTC-1 machine on a heat exchanger at a customer location an employee was hit in his leg by a crawler hose, resulting in arterial bleeding and death.

What happened?

For a still unknown reason, our colleague was hit in his leg by a crawler hose from an LTC-1 machine. This caused an arterial bleeding.

Emergency services were directly on site and provided medical assistance. Unfortunately this did not help.

Temporary measures

It is not yet known how exactly the incident could have happened. This is currently under investigation.

Without knowing whether the use of the LTC-1 has played a role in the incident, we decided to **temporarily not to use type LTC-1** anymore.

This has already been coordinated with senior management of operation.

We will take additional measures based on the results of the investigation.
