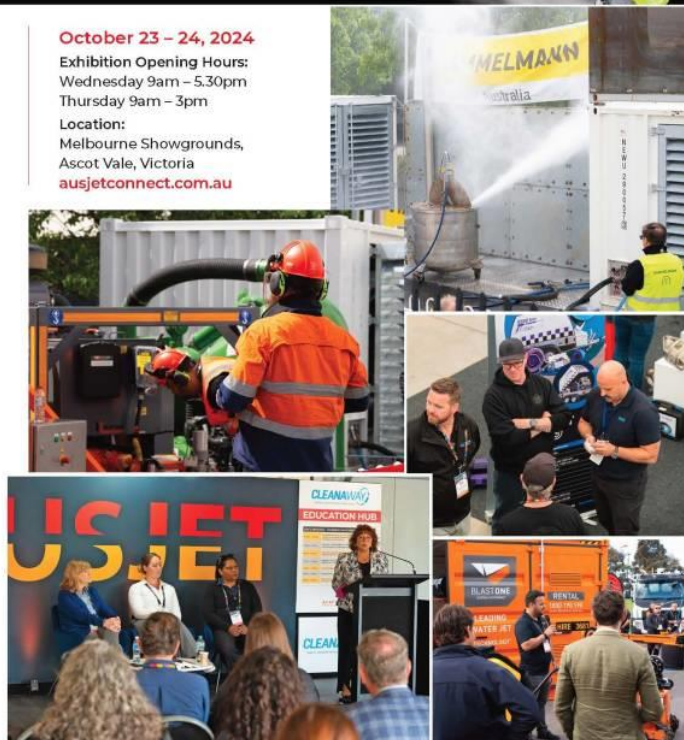

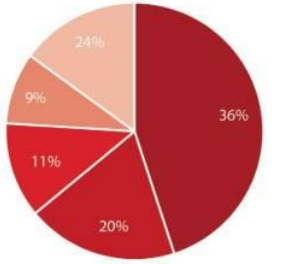

VISITOR SURVEY RESULTS

A post show survey was sent to all registered visitors a few days after the event finished and asked a range of questions about all aspects of the event including (but not limited to) marketing activities, feedback on the conference and networking events.

- 67% of respondents decided to go to AUSJET24 to find new products

- 68% went to see the latest trends

97% of visitors rated the overall event good or excellent



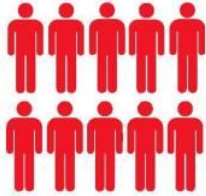

EXHIBITOR SURVEY RESULTS

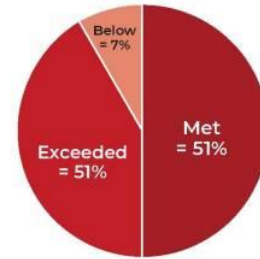
100% of 2024 Exhibitors who completed the survey, said that they would recommend Expertise Events as an event organiser to friends or colleagues. 57% rated 10/10!

MARKETING ACTIVITIES

Digital Assets and Advertising

Digital assets: 'Buttons & Banners' were provided to all exhibitors and conference speakers, and were easily available to download directly from the AUSJET24 website. These included email signature banners, web banners and social media assets, and could be used by exhibitors to promote their own participation with the event.

Digital Advertising: AUSJET24 was advertised across a range of digital platforms and publications such as Trenchless and Waste Management. When asked in the Post Show Survey about the types of advertising visitors saw, 70% reported seeing social media advertising (42% of which was on LinkedIn).



AUSJET24 Website

The AUSJET24 website included an online Exhibitor Directory where exhibitors could upload images and documentation for visitors to view or download as well as information about the Education Hub, Speakers, networking events, Demo Arenas and so much more.



Preview Guide

A preview guide brochure was mailed out before the event to prospective visitors and booked exhibitors to give to their customers. This provided potential visitors with all of the key event and Education Hub information and invited them to the event.

28% of attendees reported that they chose to come after receiving a preview magazine in the mail.

35% reported that an exhibitor showed or gave them a preview magazine or invited them to attend.



MARKETING ACTIVITIES

Print Advertising

Campaigns were run in a number of industry trade publications including Waste Management and Trenchless. This includes a mix of full, half and quarter page advertising, editorial features, and Solus EDM's. When asked about advertising in the Post Show Survey, 22% of respondents reported seeing at least one of the print adverts or articles that AUSJET24 had invested in.

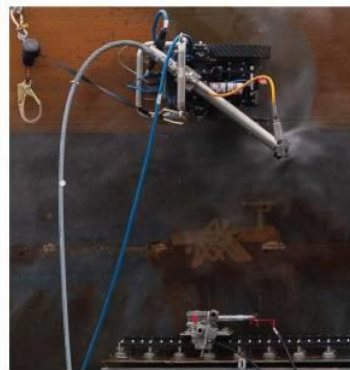

Safety Snippets

Merry Christmas

Four Seconds for Safety

Christmas is here in a few short weeks and there are lots of activities going on which can act as distractions to our work. “Did that present we ordered arrive on time?” “Did we forget to invite anyone to Christmas dinner?” “What was I supposed to bring to that Christmas party?”

It is a challenge to stay focused at work during this time of year. So, this is when it is especially important to take four seconds for safety. When you find yourself working away and your thoughts running wild with all the plans and activities of Christmas, **STOP**, take those four short seconds to look around and come back to the present moment. Look for a hazard in the middle of your activity. Are you standing on a ladder? Are you in an awkward position or about to trip on something lying on the floor? **Hazards do not go away. Only our awareness of the hazards goes away.** And when we ignore hazards, we tend to get injured.

Christmas injuries tend to put extra stress on everyone. Imagine yourself sitting around the Christmas table in a leg cast because you fell off a ladder or tripped over something. Unfortunately, these stories are more common than all of us might admit. Injuries at Christmas seem to magnify how many people are affected by an injury to one person. How many people count on you each day to come home safely? If you add them all up, you might be surprised.

Taking **four seconds for safety** may seem unimportant to you, yet it is the one activity, the one action you might take during a busy and distracted day which will have the most benefit in keeping you safe. Think of it as your Christmas present to yourself. In fact, you can think of each of those people who would be affected by an injury to you every time you take four seconds to refocus.

Think about this when you are about to drive away to some gathering this Christmas. The noise, the excitement, the distraction! Take a moment, take a big breath, count slowly to four, then drive away. Chances are that you will arrive safely once you focus for those four seconds.

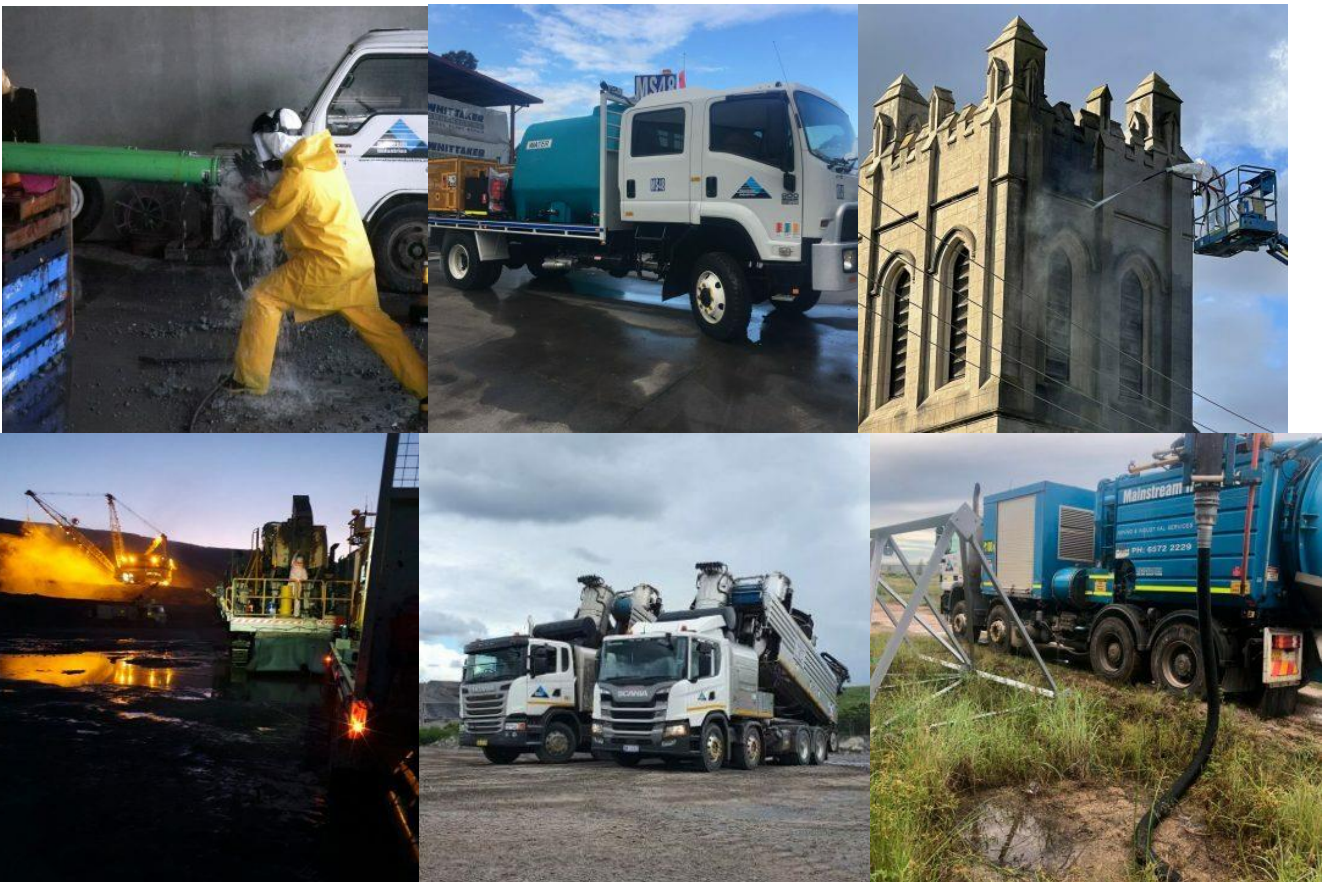
